### **ORDER:**

The Government of Tamil Nadu is committed to greater use of evidence in decision making to improve implementation and effectiveness of its poverty alleviation programmes. To this end it would like to institutionalize the use of relevant and high quality monitoring and evaluation data in the process of planning, review and course correction, targeting and allocation of resources for its various schemes and programmes. Therefore, the Government (through the State Planning Commission)

proposes to Empanel organizations and institutions that undertake research, policy advisory and consulting activities in the private, public, or not-for-profit sectors to assist the Government Departments in generating and interpreting high quality monitoring, survey, administrative and evaluation data that is relevant for policy making. Three Panels has to be constituted to serve the research and monitoring & evaluation needs of the different Departments: (1) Policy Research and Evaluation Studies (2) Independent Monitoring and (3) Data Handling, Analytics and Visualisation.

2) Accordingly, the State Planning Commission had invited Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for Empanelment of Private, Public, and Not-For-Profit Organisations and Institutions for Policy Research and Evaluation Studies / Independent Monitoring / Data Handling, Analytics and Visualisation. The Government in its letter first read above had constituted the Tender Accepting Authority Committee and the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission in his Proceeding second read above has constituted the Tender Evaluation Committee. The Tender Evaluation Committee is to supervise the opening of RFQ, to carry out the preliminary examination & detailed evaluation of RFQ received and to prepare the Evaluation Report for the consideration of Tender Accepting Authority Committee. The Tender Evaluation Committee, after detailed evaluation as per the criteria prescribed in the RFQ document has submitted its report prioritizing the eligible institutions / organizations / empanelment under the three categories Policy Research and Evaluation Studies / Independent Monitoring / Data Handling, Analytics and Visualisation. The Tender Accepting Authority Committee after scrutiny of the report of the Tender Evaluation Committee has accepted its recommendation and accordingly submitted its report empanelling the organizations / institutions. The State Planning Commission therefore in the role of the Tender Inviting Authority, in accordance with Section 10 and 30 of the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Rule 2000 has empanelled the following organizations / institutions under the respective categories:
